- This report does NOT represent the final figures for YTD through December 2022. It represents what was in MUNIS at the time of this report (2.3.2023)
- Most Revenues received in Jan-Feb are for services/expenses from prior year, & are moved back (to 2021). Thus, current year revenues are delayed.
- \$450K was removed from Handicapped Education's Expenses in November 2022 to cover shortfall in the Community College account. At the time of this report, the related \$450K reduction in budgeted revenue has not yet been made. This results in the percentages to be over reported in "Grant Total" and under reported in "Revenue".
- Large amounts of NY State Aid revenue are still to be posted/accrued in 2022.

NOTEWORTHY ITEMS, UPDATES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

12/23/22-1/19/23

- Nearly 40 Community Health Assessments and Improvement Plans have been delivered to Steering Committee members and partners.
- Heather Vroman and Kylie Holochak attended the ASAP Coalition Annual Celebration. The event celebrated accomplishments from 2022, discussed plans for Year 5 of the grant.
- Hosted Rabies Clinic in Candor. 84 dogs and 57 cats were vaccinated.
- Kylie collaborated with WIC to share and exchange information on programs and services.
- Dental Van moved to Apalachin Elementary and West Learning Center (WLC) in Apalachin. Enrollment increased drastically at WLC compared to years past.
- Dental Director reports that dental decay continues to be an increasing problem among those seen on the van; as 17% of patients seen during this time frame had extensive decay.
- Influenza cases dropped significantly over this last period, from 248 in December to 170.
- Early Intervention Service Coordinators delivered (52) holiday stockings to all children receiving EI services that had developmental toys, snacks, and educational material.
- Provider shortages continue across Early Intervention and Preschool. Currently nine children waiting for services in EI. Only agency currently doing in home evaluations has a two to three month wait.
- Lisa Schumacher received employee of 4th quarter. She is an Office Specialist I and has been with the county for over 20 years.
- Dan collaborated with Newark Valley Village Mayor for a statewide required Lead and Copper Service Inventory.
- NYSDOH Environmental Health conducted a program review of the Adolescent Tobacco Use Act (ATUPA) Program. There were no findings, and the program is in compliance.

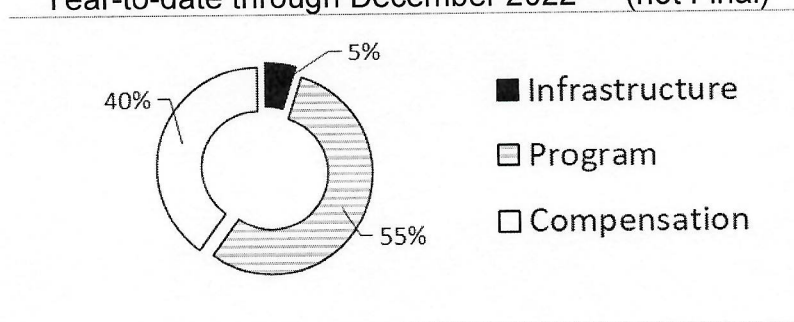

- *Notes:
1. The "Financial Snapshot" & "Allocation of Expenses" represent figures as of this report date (1/31/2023), and are not the FINAL December 2022 figures.
 2. During 2020, the Legislature required a 10% cut in expenses from all County departments. This was removed from the Expense side of the ledger, but not the offsetting revenue portion, thus inflating the reported "Local Share" of Public Health by nearly \$375K.
 3. COVID Specific funds have been removed from these tables, as they skew the numbers due to their large amounts. Currently over \$2.6 million has been appropriated of Covid funding within Public Health.
 4. In November 2022, the Treasurer, Budget Officer and Legislature transferred \$450K from Public Health to cover overages in other areas of the County. This reduced both the Expenses and Revenue lines.
 5. Information for 2023 will be added once Treasurer closes out 2022 and opens 2023 reporting in fiscal software.
